# M.Sc. Life Sciences (#): M.Sc. Life Sciences is a specific degree and no other degree shall be considered equivalent to same for eligibility for a particular seat where M.Sc. Life Sciences is mentioned for eligibility.

**Important Notes for candidates:**

1. Candidates can apply for PhD in one department only.
2. For FA category, At the time of application, the candidates must produce documents of conditional acceptance by the concerned faculty of the Institute and for OF category passing certificates (Joint CSIR-UGC NET for JRF, ICMR-JRF, DBT-JRF, NBHM screening test) of result of last two years, July 2024-July 2026.
3. Eligibility will only be for seats in the department and project that they have applied for.
4. Seats will be allocated in order of their merit in the exam.
5. Successful candidates will be subjected to eligibility criteria of respective Project before admission.
6. Candidates are required to make their own arrangements for stay at their own expenses during the period of their PhD Course.
7. They are also required to identify source of funding support for their research work, as Institute is not bound to support candidates for their stay/salary/ research funding support.
8. Candidates who are allotted a seat but do not join or resign after joining, will NOT be eligible for any additional rounds of seat allocation

**III. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO Ph.D. COURSE:**

**A candidate seeking admission to course of study leading to award of a Degree of Doctor of Philosophy must possess at least one of the following qualifications from a recognized University/Institute.**

**1. DEPARTMENTS WHERE THE Ph.D. SHALL BE OFFERED**

Pre-clinical/ Clinical departments: Physiology, Biochemistry and Clinical Immunology and Rheumatology.

**2. TYPES OF Ph.D. COURSES**

The Institute offers **Full-Time Ph.D.** Course only.

**A. Educational qualifications**

The educational qualification varies with the projects approved for Ph.D. The prospective guides would set the qualifications depending on the project they would allot to the student. A candidate seeking admission to the course of study leading to the award of Degree of Doctor of Philosophy must possess at least one of the following qualifications awarded either by this Institute or any other University/ Institute recognized by a regulatory authority such as University Grants Commission (UGC) of India, Pharmacy Council of India, All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), Nursing Council of India and Medical Council of India (MCI) or similar regulatory authorities if the college or the university is outside India:

**a. Medical qualifications:** MBBS/ BDS with minimum **60% aggregate marks** or Doctor of Medicine (D.M.) or Magister of Chirurgical (M.Ch.) or Doctor of Medicine (M.D.) or Master of Surgery (M.S.), Master of Dental Surgery (MDS) or Diplomat of the National Board (DNB) of Examinations or equivalent degree. Candidates who have obtained any of these degrees from medical colleges which are not recognized or considered equivalent by the Medical Council of India shall not be eligible to apply.

**b. Non-Medical:** For non-medical candidates, eligibility shall be a Master's Degree (two/ three-year course) awarded by Indian Universities or equivalent - Master's degree in education or Education Technology (M.Ed.), Master of Veterinary Science (M. V. Sc.), M.Sc. (Nursing), M.Sc. (Laboratory Technology), M.Sc. (Speech & Hearing) or a degree of Master of Sciences/ME/M. Tech. in subjects allied to medical sciences such as Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Human Biology, Molecular Biology, Microbiology, Biotechnology, Immunology, Life Sciences including Botany, Zoology, Genetics, Cell Biology, Pharmacology, Pharmacy, Organic Chemistry, Anthropology, Human Genomics Virology, Psychology, Sociology, Social work, Public Health/Community Health or MPH. Candidate should have at least 60% marks in the last eligibility examination qualified. Candidates possessing a Master's Degree through distance learning courses shall not be eligible.

**B. Seat category wise qualification.**

**i. Own Fellowship (OF)** For applicants with their own fellowships from recognized Government agencies:

A candidate who is a recipient of a fellowship from government/ semi government organizations such as the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), Department of Science

and Technology (DST), Department of Biotechnology (DBT), University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Defense Research and Development Organization (DRDO), Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), Indian Council for Agricultural Research (ICAR), Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD), and similar national-level organizations, or should preferably have qualified in any one of the national-level entrance tests in the last 2 years such as Joint CSIR-UGC NET for JRF, ICMR JRF, ICMR-SRF, DBT-JRF, NBHM screening test, INSPIRE fellowship, etc. conducted by these agencies.

Candidates who hold their own fellowships (i.e., individual, portable fellowships awarded by recognized national/international funding agencies) will be exempted from appearing in the Institute's Ph.D. written entrance examination, and instead be considered through a direct personal interview/evaluation route for admission into the Ph.D. program. It is limited to Full time fellowship that provide a monthly stipend (CSIR-UGC NET for JRF, ICMR JRF, ICMR-SRF, DBT-JRF, NBHM screening test, INSPIRE fellowship) and does not include project specific salary/stipend arrangements where funds are tied to specific PI's project unless explicitly permitted by the institute.

**ii. Fellowship Available in Funded Project (FA)** For funded projects that can support the fellowship of a student for at least 2 years:

Candidates selected for FA seats will be automatically appointed to the fellowship posts within those projects for which they have been selected and no further selection of staff on these posts within the project will be done. (If the fellowship has some restrictions on the eligibility of candidates, this must be stated at the time of applying for the seat so that only eligible candidates are counseled/ allotted for those seats).

- a) The candidate can do Ph.D. only under the same faculty member who would support his/her candidature. At the time of application, the candidates must produce documents of conditional acceptance by the concerned faculty of the Institute through respective faculty's extramural project fund for a minimum of 2 years. During these two years; the candidate must also make attempt to secure their own fellowship for the years ahead.
- b) The faculty can give conditional acceptance to more than one candidate for the single seat that they offer, however, the candidate can submit conditional acceptance letter from only one faculty.
- c) The candidate who once qualified the Ph.D. entrance examination (i.e. in January or July Session) shall get himself/herself registered under the same guide (in the research scheme/project employee's category) in that very session.

### C) Other Conditions

- i) Candidates possessing a Master's degree through distance learning course shall not be eligible to apply.
- ii) There is provision of carrying forward the candidature of a candidate, who has passed the Entrance Examination of Ph.D. in a particular year and could not be admitted due to non-availability of seats in that subject as the guide has given consent letter to more than one candidate, to the next year. In such cases, he/she will need not pass the Entrance Examination of the subsequent year/session for getting admission under the Fellowship Available (FA) Category of Ph.D.

### D) Eligibility criteria for External Candidates in permanent employment:

- i. Candidates who are permanent employees of external Institutions (Central Govt/ Semi Govt/ Autonomous organization) should submit application through proper channel. i.e., employer. They will be required to submit a **'No Objection Certificate'** from their employer/Head of Institute.
- ii. In addition, such Candidates will have to provide a certificate at time of joining from employer stating that in event of selection to PhD course, Candidate will be granted a minimum period of 03-year study leave with full pay and permission to work at AIIMS BILASPUR to pursue full time PhD Course.

### IV) DURATION OF COURSE:

- i. Duration of course for all candidates will commence from date of joining (provisional registration) to submission of final thesis to exam cell for evaluation.
- ii. PhD course will be full time for all candidates.
- iii. Minimum Duration: Shall be for a minimum period of 3 years including course work.
- iv. Maximum Duration: Shall be for a period of 6 years.

## **V) METHOD OF SELECTION**

Candidates shall have to qualify through entrance examination to be eligible for the further rounds of selection as described below.

### **a) Application**

All candidates will apply online within the stipulated deadline as and when the advertisement is floated by the institute.

***The candidates applying for FA category have to submit conditional acceptance letter from the faculty under which he/she wants to pursue Ph.D. The candidate will only be considered for that faculty only.***

***The candidates applying for OF category have to submit the pass result National level examination (mentioned above).***

Further guidelines on submission of hard copies shall be as per the advertisement.

### **b) Selection Procedure – Entrance Examination**

Candidates applying for FA category only must appear for a written examination. OF candidates need not to appear in the written exam. The details of the same are given below.

Of these, the FA candidates (up to three times the advertised seats) need the minimum 50% marks in the written examination will be shortlisted for the interview based on their rank in the written examination. The selection for Ph.D. registration will be through a three-stage performance evaluation for FA category as under:

**STAGE I - Aptitude Test:** Total Marks = 40; Total Duration: 40 Minutes

The exam shall consist of 40 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of 1 Mark each) covering Logical reasoning, English (written and verbal skills), Biostatistics, Research Methodology, Lab Technology, general awareness, etc. For Stage I, there will be 1/3 negative marking and every incorrect answer shall lead to a deduction of 1/3 mark from the total.

*The Stage I exam (Aptitude test) shall be qualifying in nature and candidates must secure at least 50% marks in the Stage I exam to be eligible for evaluation of the Stage II exam.*

**Stage II - Subject Test:** Total Marks = 80; Total Duration: 80 Minutes

The exam shall consist of 80 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of 1 Mark each covering the subject-related questions of M.Sc. level. *Different papers shall be made available to each category of students, as below:*

- *Medical Qualification:* Subject-related questions from related medical specialties.
- *Non-Medical Qualification:* Subject-related questions of M.Sc. level.

For Stage II, there will be negative marking and every incorrect answer shall lead to a deduction of 1/3 mark. Candidates must score at least 40 marks in Stage II to be eligible for Stage III. However, the candidate must also secure 50% each in Stage I (Qualifying) and Stage II separately. The marks shall not be disclosed at this stage and only a list of eligible candidates shall be displayed.

### **STAGE III – Interview**

#### ***Eligibility for Stage III:***

1. Candidates for FA category must score 50% marks in each stage of examination.
2. Candidates with own fellowship (JRF/ SRF) – Candidates qualified in any one of the National Entrance Tests leading to the award of a fellowship tenable at AIIMS, Bilaspur (H.P.) in the last 2 years (July 2024 to July 2026), e.g., Joint CSIR-UGC NET for JRF, ICMR – JRF, ICMR- SRF, DBT – JRF, NBHM screening test, INSPIRE fellowship, GATE fellowship, etc.

#### **Interview**

Based on the marks obtained in Stage II, three (03) times as many candidates as the number of seats advertised in a department will be invited for an interview with the Departmental Committees depending on their choices submitted at the time of application. The candidates shall have to appear for an interview conducted by the Departmental Ph.D. Admission Committee, for which the maximum marks shall be 20. The Departmental Ph.D.-Admission Committee will interview and assess the candidates mainly for his/ her

interest and knowledge in the concerned subject and research topic or area of interest.

**Final result** will be prepared by addition of marks of interview and stage II, Maximum Marks 100 (20+80) will be added to the marks of stage II to determine the final total 100 marks. Selection of candidates will be based on merit and number of seats available.

Note:

- i. Result will be available on website of AIIMS BILASPUR. No individual intimation will be communicated to the candidate.
- ii. Candidates who fail to attend any of the stage of examination as mentioned above will NOT be eligible for admission

**g) Method of Resolving Tie:** The tie cases will be resolved according to age (Date of birth), the older candidate shall get preference over the younger one. Marks obtained in qualifying examination.

#### **VI) JOINING:**

Selected candidates are required to join **as per the date given in his/her provisional offer letter**. In case the candidate is not granted an extension for joining and fails to join by the date given to him/her in provisional offer letter, it will be assumed that he/she does not intend to join the course and the seat will be offered to the next candidate on the waiting list. No further correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

#### **VII) IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING UP APPLICATION FORM:**

1. For applying for admission to PhD Course each candidate is required to fill online form & submit hard copy of signed application form provided on the website to **Dean (Exam), AIIMS BILASPUR(HP), Ground Floor, Admin Block** through registered post/ speed post. The envelope should be super scribed as "APPLICATION FORM FOR PHD ADMISSION JULY 2026 as mentioned in the important dates at a glance of prospectus."
2. **No candidate should register more than one application.**
3. Candidate should fill application taking utmost care. Incorrectly filled form may lead to rejection. It will be the responsibility of the candidates to ensure that correct details are filled. The Institute will not be responsible for any incorrect information/cancellation of candidature/loss or lack of communication etc. due to incorrectly filled Application form. Applicants must fill all the fields carefully since after submission of application request for change in any information at any later stage will NOT be considered. Candidates should keep a copy of the form for future reference till the completion of admission process.
4. The fee for entrance examination is non-refundable and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained. The candidate is required to go through the Prospectus carefully and acquaint himself/herself with all requirements with regard to ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA of filling of the application form. Candidates may please note that unless they make the payment of Application Fee, their application will be treated as INCOMPLETE.
5. Payment of fee: Candidates can pay the application fee through NEFT or direct bank transfer. Additional charges viz. bank charges, service tax etc. incurred while making online payment of application fees will be borne by the candidate.
6. Candidates are advised to take a print of the payment receipt where they can see transaction number or UTR number, the receipt to be attached with the application also. Communication regarding exam will be sent on the email of candidate (as provided in the application form) well in advance of the date of examination.
7. Payment of application fees by any other mode viz Cash, Cheque, Money Orders, Postal Orders, Pay Orders, Banker's Cheques, Postal Stamps, etc., will NOT be accepted. Such applications will be summarily rejected. The decision of Director, AIIMS BILASPUR in this regard shall be final and binding.
8. APPLICATION FEE AND MODE OF PAYMENT:
  - General/OBC Category: Rs. 2000/- + Transaction Charges as applicable.

- SC/ST/EWS Category: Rs. 1600/- + Transaction Charges as applicable.
  - PWBD Candidates are exempted from any Fee.
9. For all purposes, for candidate applying under SC/ST/OBC(NCL)/EWS/ & PWBD category, the candidate must possess a valid certificate issued by competent authority (as applicable to the category in format provided by AIIMS BILASPUR).
10. **OBC Caste Certificate should be issued after 01/04/2026 (as per format attached). An EWS Certificate issued in prescribed format for employment in Central Govt.on the basis of income of Financial Year 2025-26 issued after 01.04.2026 but not later than 25.06.2026 valid for the year 2026-27 will be considered valid. (as per format attached)**

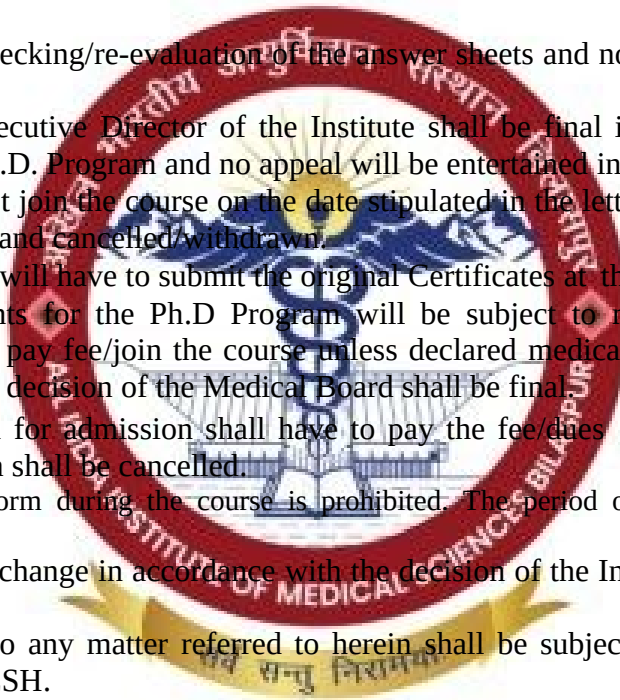

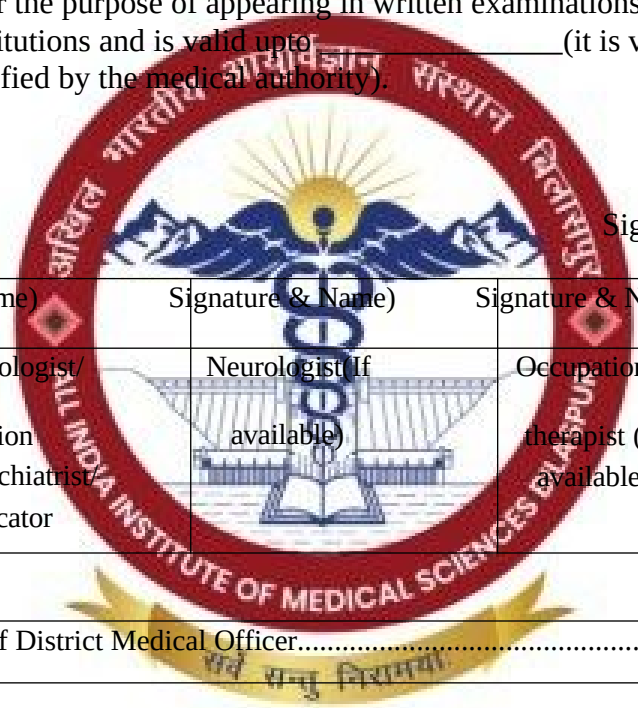
