Subject: Instructions for Reporting for Admission for AIIMS-Bilaspur (NEET-UG 2026)

Dear Student,

On behalf of AIIMS Bilaspur, I congratulate you and your family on your success.

As per the result of the first round of Counselling conducted by the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) for NEET-UG 2026 admissions, you have been allotted admission at AIIMS, Bilaspur. Please read the instructions provided by MCC regarding the process of reporting and taking admission on the MCC website. As per the schedule of the Medical Counselling Committee (MCC), you are now required to report at the Academic Section, Undergraduate Cell, AIIMS, Bilaspur, to complete the process of Admission from **20th to 25th August 2026**. However, the candidates are advised to regularly check the MCC website for any updates or revision to the counselling schedule. In case of any revision, the reporting period of AIIMS, Bilaspur shall be revised accordingly, then candidates need to report strictly as per the revised guidelines of AIIMS, Bilaspur. Candidates are advised to keep checking their E-mails, MCC website for regular updates.

- List of Documents to be brought on the day of reporting

A. Exam and Counselling related

1. Application Form/Confirmation Page of NEET.
2. Provisional Seat Allotment Letter: Issued by MCC
3. Identity Proof (As mentioned in the NTA NEET information Bulletin)
4. Admit card – Original Print
5. NEET/NTA Scorecard – Original Print
6. Proof of Date of Birth (Birth certificate or 10th Std. Certificate)
7. Pass Certificate & Statement of Marks (12th Std.)
8. Category Certificate (*if any*)
9. Migration Certificate: Issued from the University/Board last attended by him/her.
10. Aadhar Card photocopy
11. 4 passport-size photographs.
12. Gap certificate affidavit (*if applicable*).

B. Eligibility and category related

1. Certificate from the Board from which he/she passed the 10th/High School/Higher Secondary Examination, showing his/her date of birth.
2. Certificate & Mark sheet from the Board from which he/she passed the 10+2 or equivalent Examination showing that he/she has secured 60% or more marks (50% in case of SC/ST Candidates & 45% for persons with Benchmark Disability) in aggregate in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
3. Migration Certificate from the University/Board last attended by him/her.

C. Applicable only to candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Tribe/OBC/EWS/OPH Category:

1. SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority. Community should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
2. OBC-NCL Certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the central list of OBC. OBC candidates should not belong to the creamy layer. OBC-NCL certificate must be in the prescribed format. (The OBC-NCL certificates issued from **01 April 2025** (inclusive) to the start of reporting of Round-1 of MBBS counselling as notified by (MCC) will be considered valid for admission for NEET (UG) 2026. Candidate should bring both OBC & NCL certificates for reporting.
3. EWS Certificate issued by the competent authority. The EWS certificates issued from **01 April 2025** (inclusive) to the start of reporting of Round 1 of MBBS counselling as notified by (MCC) will be considered valid for admission for NEET (UG) 2026.
4. Disability Certificate issued from prescribed authority showing that he/she belongs to Persons with Benchmark Disability Category along with the medical assessment from the designated medical assessment centers/boards by the MCC, if applicable.

NOTE: The candidates must bring two sets of copies of the above-mentioned documents while reporting for document submission.

Those candidates who join the MBBS course at AIIMS, Bilaspur, his/her original certificates will be retained, and the same will not be returned to the candidate before completion of the course.
